This section provides a range of research and publications from Migration Yorkshire or other agencies and organisations.

- Children's Commissioner reported the conditions faced by young refugees in a briefing on 'Detention of unaccompanied children arriving in Kent during 2020' (recent version published in February 2021)
- Civil Society LOIPR Submission to the UN Committee on the Rights of the Child sets out priority issues and difficulties regularising status for undocumented children. (recent version published in December 2020)
- Refugee Support Network for UNICEF UK provides a report about refugee children's access to education, including analysis of delays in accessing education in the UK. (recent version published in July 2018)
- Project play published advocacy reports on 'Evictions -practices that violate children's rights on the Franco-British border' (recent version published in September 2020)
